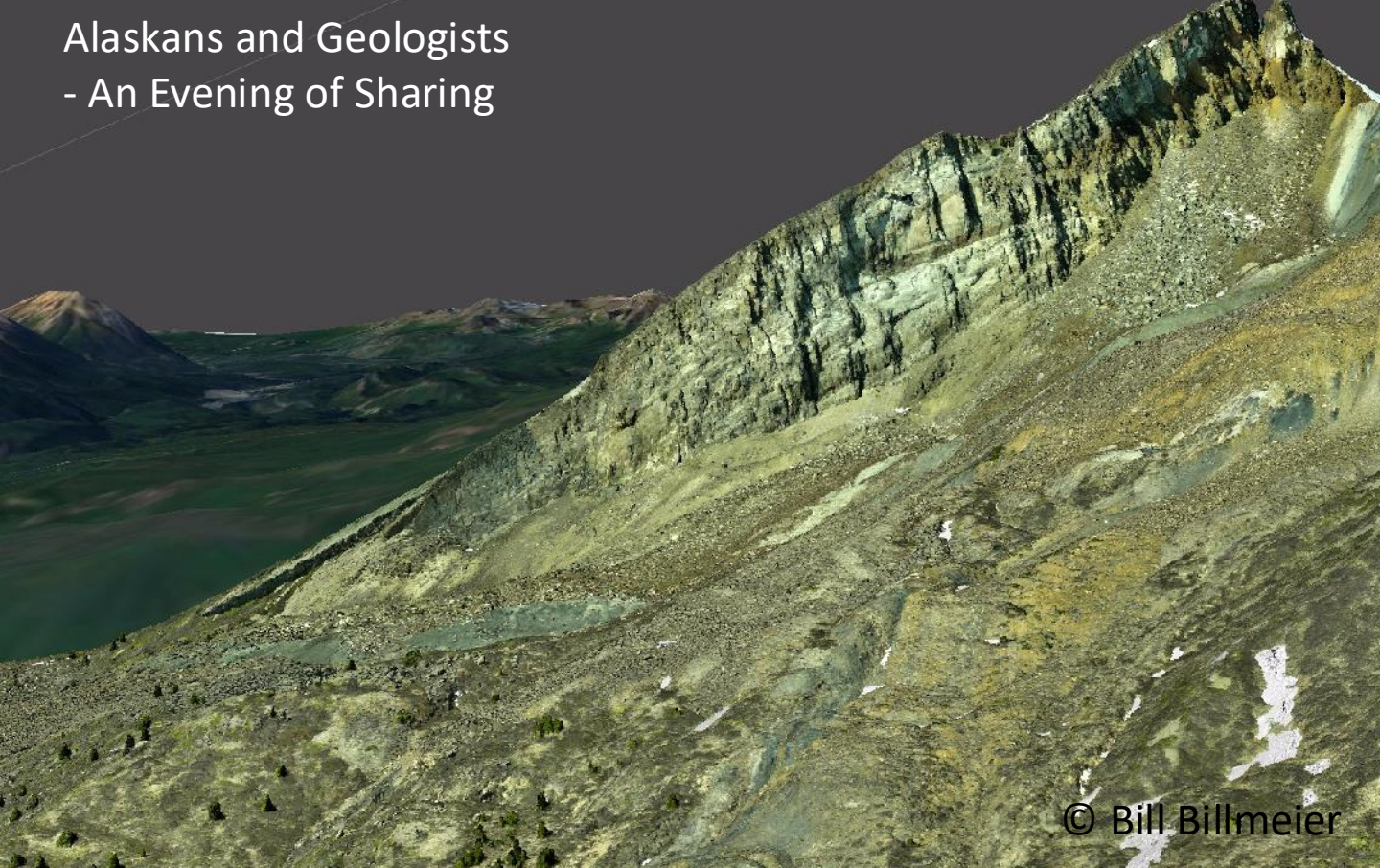


# Alaskans and Geologists - An Evening of Sharing
